

US-31 BR (Colby Street/Thompson Street) Reconstruction and Widening City of Whitehall April - June 2017

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be completing a combination of resurfacing and reconstruction with widening on US-31 Business Route (BR) (Colby Street/Thompson Street) in Whitehall from the White River bridge to east of Hall Street.

- Resurfacing (with no widening) will occur from the White River Bridge east to Division Street.
- Reconstruction and lane widening to 11 feet, along with storm sewer replacement, will occur between Division Street and Franklin Street.
- Resurfacing (with no widening) will occur from Franklin Street to east of Hall Street.

In addition to the roadwork, water main will be relocated and upgraded, and sidewalk ramps will be upgraded to be

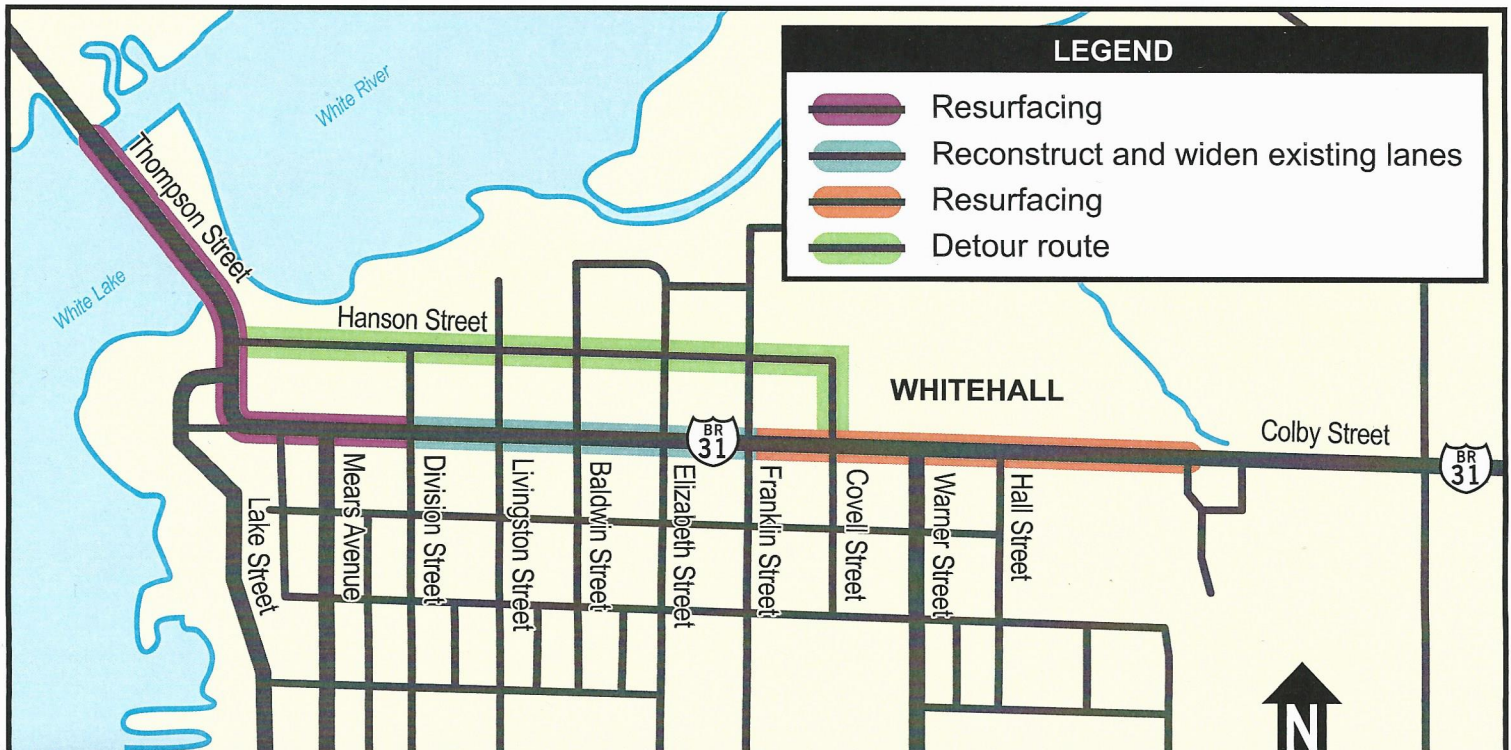
compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act. The City of Whitehall will also be completing a streetscaping project along US-31 BR in coordination with this project.

When Will This Be Done?

Work will begin in April and is scheduled to be completed by late June.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Lane closures will be in effect throughout the project. During reconstruction, traffic will be detoured on Hanson and Covell streets. Residential and business access will be maintained within the detour limits. Pedestrian traffic will be detoured where sidewalk closures are necessary.
